

Instructions

As part of an experiment conducted at the department of economics, we would like you to participate in a game. Please read the instructions **carefully**. If you have any questions, raise your hand and wait for the seminar teacher to come to you. Do not talk to any other participants.

Your participation is voluntary, but you will be paid for your participation and the size of your reward will depend on your own decisions as well as the decisions of other participants. Your earnings will be paid out via Swish (if you have it) before the end of the week. If you do not have Swish, you will be contacted after the experiment for your reward. Note that all of your actions in the experiment are anonymous; the person who handles the payment of earnings does not know how the earnings were obtained.

In this game, you are randomly and anonymously matched with another participant who is performing the same task as you in a different room. Neither of you will receive any information about who the other person is, neither before nor after the experiment.

The game looks like this:

		The other participant's action	
		A	B
Your action	A	50 50	0 70
	B	70 0	20 20

You and the other participant choose simultaneously between actions A and B. Depending on your choices, you end up in one of the four cells in the table above. In each of these cells, the **bold** number in the bottom-left corner shows **your payoff**. The number in the top-right corner shows the payoff of the other participant.

In other words,

- If you both choose A, you both get 50 SEK.
- If you both choose B, you both get 20 SEK.
- If you choose A and the other participant chooses B, you get 0 SEK and the other participant gets 70 SEK.
- If you choose B and the other participant chooses A, you get 70 SEK and the other participant gets 0 SEK.
