

Improving State Capacity to Target Extreme Poverty: An Evaluation of a Randomized Intervention in Bangladesh

– Pre-Analysis Plan –

Note: We obtained IRB Approval for this study on 30 July 2019 from BRAC University James P. Grant (JPG) School of Public Health (IRB #: 2019-021-IR) and on 7 November 2019 from Innovations for Poverty Action (IPA) (IRB #: 10198).

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1. Introduction

In this Pre-Analysis Plan (PAP), we describe the research design for the evaluation of a randomized intervention that we designed to improve the selection of beneficiaries by local governments for Bangladesh's social pension scheme - the Old Age Allowance (OAA).

In 2018, we conducted an extensive pilot data collection. The analysis of this data was pre-registered as a PAP at the time via originstamp.org. We make this PAP available as one of the files belonging to the registration of this randomized controlled trial (RCT) in the AEA RCT Registry. Our experiences and insights are described in detail in a draft working paper that we also make available. This pilot study shows that the selection of beneficiaries does not well reflect the government's eligibility criteria. Instead, we observe high rates of mistargeting and show that beneficiaries are not significantly more eligible than non-beneficiaries. We further find clear evidence that local government representatives (LGs) and elderly lack knowledge of the eligibility criteria. Responsible LGs further lack tools or practical assistance to target the benefits as they should according to the government guidelines. They select either on an ad-hoc basis in open field selections¹ or without any transparency in closed meetings. Neither of these two approaches

follows the national government's guidelines for the selection of beneficiaries. There is thus an urgent need for improvement.

Drawing from these insights, we have prepared the implementation of an intervention that focuses on enhancing capacity of the local government officials and representatives for the selection of beneficiaries for the Old Age Allowance and to evaluate this intervention in an RCT. Randomly selected unions will either be assigned to a treatment group where the intervention is implemented or to a control group in which no intervention will take place.

The remainder of this PAP is structured as follows. In Section 2, we describe our experimental design (including details on the intervention, the randomization method, sample size and power calculations) and state our main hypotheses. Finally, Section 3 gives an outlook to planned updates of this PAP in the future.

2. Experimental design and empirical analysis

a. Intervention

As mentioned above, we will use an RCT to examine how the provision of practical support for the selection of beneficiaries can improve the targeting of the Old Age Allowance in Bangladesh. Our intervention has the following two components:

- **Training for selection committee members:** In collaboration with the Department of Social Services (DSS) and with the National Social Service Academy (NASS), under Ministry of Social Welfare, we developed a training for all members of the Union selection committees on the selection criteria for the OAA, and the 'eligibility information card' (EIC). The eligibility information card can be used to collect all relevant information according to the government manual on the elderly person incl. identifying information, age, receipt of other benefits, physical ability to work as well as economic and social living condition. We will provide the training with our own trainers. The training consists of videos and structured verbal interactions as well as a practice session and will be provided one-to-one to every selection committee member. We will provide the training with our own trainers and carry out the training of trainers jointly together with the NASS.

about their living situation, such as work of their children and whom they are staying with. In the open field selections that we have attended the primary focus shifted to the year of birth of the elderly and during this selection process - the older people attending were prioritized. We did not observe any systematic checking of the eligibility criteria prescribed by the government.

- **Filling eligibility information cards for elderly:** We will fill eligibility information cards for elderly. One copy will be transferred to the selection committee members after taking elderly's consent. The elderly will keep the original and can use it to provide all relevant information to the selection committee members to apply for the OAA. Miking announcements will be used to inform elderly in the unions about field activities (venue and date).

While the training will be provided to all the selection committee members in a union (17 local government representatives and one union social worker), the filling of EICs will take place in three randomly selected wards in the union. We will provide the copies of the filled EICs from three wards to the Union selection committees.

b. Baseline data collection and planned endline data collection

Our baseline data collection focused on capturing whether and to what extent union selection committee members know the eligibility rules for the Old Age Allowance. Apart from these knowledge questions, we also collected data on their need for support for selecting beneficiaries and their willingness to lie for private gain using a dice game. The questionnaire further covered socio-economic variables such as education, literacy, land ownership and income as well as working experience as local government representative and party affiliation.

Our sample consisted of all 18 selection committee members from all 76 unions in our study area, in total 1378 individuals. Our team of enumerators managed to interview 92% of them. The remaining 8% were either not reachable, postponed the call multiple times because they were busy or stated being unwilling to participate. Surveys lasted between 25 and 30 minutes.

We plan to collect endline data between July and September 2020 from newly selected beneficiaries and from union selection committee members. We will collect data from three wards from each treatment and control union. We will also collect data from three extra wards from treatment unions (15 beneficiaries per ward, see power calculation below). While selection committee members from these wards will be trained on the OAA beneficiary selection rules, the listing of the elderly was not done in these three extra wards allowing us to measure the impact of having provided only the training to having provided training and filled EICs for the elderly in the target group.

Our endline data collection will be focused on capturing whether our intervention improved the targeting of the benefits. Further, it will include questions on potential mediating variables, such as knowledge of the OAA rules on the part of the selection committee members. We will also collect data on socio-economic variables such as education, literacy, land ownership and income as well as working experience as local government representative and party affiliation.

c. Location and randomization

The intervention will be implemented in the rural areas of the Rangpur and Rajshahi divisions in 38 out of 76 randomly selected unions. The districts in the study region are Thakurgaon, Rangpur, Panchagarh, Nilphamari, Gaibandha and Dinajpur in the Rangpur Division and Bogura, Chapainawabganj, Joypurhat, Naogaon, Natore, Pabna, Rajshahi and Sirajgonj in the Rajshahi Division. The random selection of unions into treatment and control group will allow us to measure the causal impact of the intervention.

To finalize the study area and assignment of treatment and control group we went through the following steps:

1. We created a list of unions² of the Rajshahi and Rangpur division using the “National Report Volume-02: Union Statistics, 2011” from the Population and Housing Census, by the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics.³
2. We manually created another list of unions from the Local Government Engineering Department website and called Upazila Social Service Officer or Upazila Nirbahi Officer or Union Chairman, Union Secretary in case of any mismatch to update the list of unions.
3. After finalizing the list of unions, we dropped urban areas.
4. We identified highly flood prone sub-districts (upazilas) based on the flood map by the Space Research and Remote Sensing Organisation (SPARRSO) of Bangladesh.⁴ SPARRSO divides Bangladesh’s land area into four categories: A (Severe Flash Flooding, Severe River Flooding, Severe Tidal Surge), B (Moderate Flash Flooding, Moderate River Flooding, Moderate Tidal Surge), C (Low Flash Flooding, Low River

Flooding) and D (Not Flood Prone). We dropped category A (severe flood prone) sub-districts from our study region.


5. After dropping severe flood prone areas, 83 sub-districts (upazilas) were left from the Rajshahi and Rangpur division out of 125 sub-districts. We randomly selected one union from each sub-district for the baseline.
6. We selected 83 unions from 83 sub-districts in total. We surveyed all Union selection committee members for the OAA from the selected unions for baseline. After completion of the baseline survey, we dropped 6 unions from where we could not survey the UP Chairman⁵ (President of the Union Committee for OAA) and one union based on the least number of completed surveys of Union Committee members.
7. From the remaining 76 unions, we randomly assigned one union to the treatment group and one union to the control group from each district. If there were more than two unions from any district, we equally divided them into these two groups. In case there was any odd number of unions from any district, we assigned the remaining one union either to the treatment and control group.
8. As explained earlier, we fill the EICs for elderly only in three wards from each union. Each union has nine wards and each UP Women Member represents three wards. To take this into account, we randomly selected one ward from the three wards represented by each UP Women member for the listing component of the intervention.

d. Project timeline

We obtained government approval for the intervention in August 2019 and completed the baseline data collection in October 2019. We piloted the interventions in Spring 2019 and an improved version in November 2019. Based on our exchange with the Department of Social Services, the next round of beneficiary selection is expected to take place between March and May 2020. We will train the trainers and the listing officers in the beginning of January 2020 and implement the intervention in January - February 2020. The data collection will take place after the selection of beneficiaries in Summer 2020. Figure 1 summarizes the timeline of the project. The milestones in blue have already been completed, the upcoming intervention itself is shaded in green and the later stages in gray.

⁵ Union Parishad representatives are UP Chairman (Head) and nine UP Members from nine wards. There are also three UP Women Members who are not elected and represents three wards each from a union.

e. Sample size and power


Our power calculations are based on our pilot data collected in May 2018, which allows us to estimate the mean and standard deviation of our main outcome variables of interest, and the intra-cluster correlation coefficients. We chose the number of clusters and observations per cluster with the goal of being able to detect a reduction of the wealth index of the newly selected beneficiaries of 25% of a standard deviation. Figure 2 illustrates this.

f. Main hypothesis

Our main research hypothesis is that providing practical support to local decision makers and the elderly will improve the targeting of social pensions towards the elderly poor. We expect that newly selected beneficiaries in the treatment unions will be on average more eligible than newly selected beneficiaries in the control unions. We further expect that our intervention will reduce the leakages and the relevance of illegitimate factors, such as personal connections or political incentives. As we have not finalized the questionnaire for

the endline data collection yet, we do not specify more detailed hypotheses and analyses at this point.

3. Outlook

We will update this PAP before the collection of any endline data (that is, before July 2020 on the AEA RCT registry (socialscienceregistry.org)). The whole history of changes to the registration will be visible on socialscienceregistry.org.


