

We will analyze effects on primary outcomes for program participants (women), including outcomes related to education, learning, marriage, childbearing, physical health, mental health, income generating activities, intimate partner violence and bargaining power, as well as that of children including outcomes related to health and child development. We will run OLS regressions with strata fixed effects and clustering standard errors at the community level. We will explore effects separately among women who experienced the full program effect versus those who did not. Furthermore, we will explore heterogeneity by whether women were in or out of school at baseline and women's social conservatism measured at baseline.
