

This survey is about daily life and work from home

*Half of the respondents randomly gets the 5 Vignettes A and the other half gets the 5 Vignettes B. The Vignettes A and B vary the gender of the main character and the work location. **Everyone in the same household gets the same vignette!***

Vignettes A

Rob and Petra live together. They both work full-time and earn about the same money. Both Rob's job and Petra's jobs are about half an hour commute from their home.

A1
